Leader's Guide for 2-Hour Class

### **Lesson #12: Jesus, Son of God**

#### **Welcome Prayer & Class Review of previous weeks: (30-45 minutes)**

For the last class of Part 1, have the class participate in a comprehensive review on all 12 lessons of Christ. This can be done together as a class or print off questions for each table to review. You can use the questions below as review questions or print out the full comprehensive review from the Resources download link on [BigDreamMinistries.org](http://BigDreamMinistries.org).

#### Class Review:

- 1) What is the Davidic covenant?
  - a) A king would remain forever from David's line
  
- 2) At the fullness of time, the Messiah would come (Galatians 4:4-7). What does the fullness of time mean?
  - a) The timing was right, both political and geographical. The Greek language was a one-world language for all. The Roman road system made communication easier.
  
- 3) Who was Elizabeth and Zachariah's child?
  - a) John the Baptist

What was his role?

  - a) Forerunner to Jesus

What was his message?

  - a) "Repent, the kingdom of God is at hand."
  
- 4) When John the Baptist saw Jesus coming to him, what did he say?
  - a) "Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world."
  
- 5) After Jesus is baptized in righteousness, the Spirit of God descends as a dove and the voice of God comes out of the heavens. What did God say?
  - a) "This is My Beloved Son, in whom I am well-pleased."
  
- 6) Where was Jesus baptized and by whom?
  - a) Jordan River, John the Baptist
  
- 7) Why is Jesus called the Lamb of God?
  - a) An unblemished lamb was sacrificed during each Passover and delivered them from death while in Egypt. Jesus offered Himself as the perfect lamb, conquering power of sin and death.

- 8) After Jesus was baptized, he went into the wilderness to be tempted, so that He could identify with our weaknesses. What are the three ways He was tempted?
- Lust of the eyes – to provide for yourself
  - Lust of the flesh - to protect yourself
  - Pride - to exalt yourself
- 9) Who are the first five disciples?
- Andrew – from Capernaum
  - John – both Andrew and John were followers of John the Baptist
  - Simon – Andrew tells his brother Simon that they found the Messiah, and Jesus names him Peter
  - Phillip – Jesus tells him to “follow me”
  - Nathaniel – Phillip tells Nathaniel, who says, “Can anything good come out of Nazareth?” When Jesus sees him coming, He says, “Behold an Israelite indeed, of whom there is no deceit”. It was as if Jesus already knew all about him.
- 10) Where does Jesus perform His first miracle?
- Cana. Jesus creates new wine from water. It is fully mature wine, demonstrating Jesus the Creator
- 11) On Jesus’ first visit to the Temple in Jerusalem during His ministry, what does He do?
- He cleanses the Temple of the merchants and money changers
- 12) To whom did Jesus say, “For God so loved the world, He gave His only Son.”?
- Nicodemus
- 13) What does it mean to be “born again?”
- A new spiritual birth imparted by God to those who believe in Jesus
- 14) What did Jesus reveal to the Samaritan woman at the well?
- He was the Messiah; He was the Living Water
- How did Jesus show His deity to the woman at the well?
- He knew everything about her
- What was significant about the location of Samaria?
- It was out of the way for Jesus to travel. The Jews did not associated with Samaritans.
- 15) Where did Jesus set up His headquarters?
- Capernaum
- Why do you think He chose this as His headquarters?
- It was in Galilee, occupied by Rome. It had a large fishing industry, lots of trade and people from different countries.
- Isaiah said this area lived in darkness but would see a great light.

16) What were some of the reason Jesus was rejected by the religious officials?

- a) He was not the kind of king they were expecting
- b) They didn't truly love God and want to see God among them
- c) They like to be honored among the people
- d) They didn't believe the Scriptures

17) Jesus was undoubtedly a great teacher, but He was also the Teacher of Righteousness. Jesus gives the greatest sermon ever told as a model for our behavior and character. What is this sermon and where is it found in the New Testament?

- a) The Sermon on the Mount, Matthew 5-7

What does righteousness mean?

- a) Being right with God, which we accomplish through the Holy Spirit and not of ourselves

18) What is the central theme to Jesus' parables?

- a) The Kingdom of Heaven, the greatest treasure.

19) What things did Jesus tell His disciples before sending them out to preach and heal?

- a) Don't go in the way of the Gentiles; do not enter any city of the Samaritans
- b) Go to the lost Sheep of Israel and preach "the King of heaven is at hand"
- c) Don't take anything with you except your tunic and a staff
- d) Don't charge anyone but accept support when given
- e) Stay at those who are worthy and give a blessing
- f) Shake the dust off your feet of those who will not accept your message or receive you

20) Why should the disciples not worry what they were to say before governor and kings?

- a) It will be given you in that hour what to say, for the Spirit of God speaks through you

21) What is one new thing you have learned about Jesus that you did not know or realize before this study? (answers will vary, some suggestions below)

- a) Joy-giver
- b) Jesus traveled a lot, always on the move
- c) Jesus was intentional with purpose, but gradually lead people to the truth
- d) The magnitude of people who came, and from far away
