

<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • His book contains more prophecy about Jesus Christ than any other Old Testament book • His book is like a miniature Bible • Prophesied about a voice calling “clear the way for the Lord” • Theme of book is Israel’s Messiah Promised <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Isaiah)</p>	<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prophesied to Jerusalem during the final 40 years before her destruction by Babylon • Consecrated by God before he was born, he was commanded not to marry • Called the weeping prophet, as he predicted and witnessed Jerusalem’s destruction <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Jeremiah)</p>
<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wrote his book to the exiles living in Babylon before, during, and after the final exile, to encourage them to stay away from the sin which caused the exile • Prophesied through extraordinary visions, signs and symbols, and saw the dry bones • Also called the Patmos-seer of the Old Testament, as he was exiled similar to John <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Ezekiel)</p>	<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Interpreted Nebuchadnezzar’s dreams • Refused King Darius’ order not to petition any god but him • Theme of his book is God’s supremacy over nations and also shows the Gentiles’ future <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Daniel)</p>
<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gave example of Israel’s spiritual adultery through his prostituting wife Gomer, whom he later redeemed • Prophesied Israel would be destroyed and scattered, and no longer have God’s presence or enjoy the land God gave them • Prophesied that God will gather His people in the future, live in the land and God will be their husband and never again a divorce <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Hosea)</p>	<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Used an example of locust invasion as a picture of future tribulation • Wrote to Judah warning them that if they did not turn from their wicked ways and idolatry, the Day of the Lord, a day of God’s wrath and judgment, was at hand • Prophesied God will save a remnant and Jerusalem will once again be a Holy city <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Joel)</p>
<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Used visual pictures such as the plumb line to show Israel they were not “straight” and would receive God’s judgement • A country farmer turned city prophet • One of two prophets who wrote to the Northern Kingdom Israel (the other was Hosea) <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Amos)</p>	<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prophesied of Edom’s coming destruction: Pride leads to conflict and ends in destruction • Earliest of the writing prophets • Contemporary of Elijah <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Obediah)</p>

<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Delivered a message to the people of Ninevah, Assyria Preach message that God loves and has compassion on the whole world His message brought a nationwide repentance which stayed the wrath of God <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Jonah)</p>	<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Gave the specific prophecy that the Savior would be born in Bethlehem His phrase is seen in the Congressional Library, "What does the Lord require of you but to do justice, to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?" Prophesied the promise of the Messiah's first and second coming <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Micah)</p>
<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Name means comfort. He brought comfort to Judah who lived under the shadow of fear from the Assyrians Prophesied of Nineveh's deserved destruction Spoke against Nineveh 120 years after Jonah <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Nahum)</p>	<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Questioned God with honesty, but concluded God is good and He can be trusted even when we do not understand His ways Called the "thinker" among the prophets Written to Judah a few years before the Babylonian conquer, he had seen the evil in Judah and it grieved him, and he asked God to do something about it, but God's answer was not what he was expecting <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Habakkuk)</p>
<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Gave example of Israel's spiritual adultery through his prostituting wife Gomer, whom he later redeemed Prophesied Israel would be destroyed and scattered, and no longer have God's presence or enjoy the land God gave them Prophesied that God will gather His people in the future, live in the land and God will be their husband and never again a divorce <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Hosea)</p>	<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Prophesied about the Day of the Lord, which would include judgement and joy Had royal heritage as the great-great-grandson of King Jezekeiah of Judah, a king who had boldly and fervently brought religious reform to his nation Contemporary of Jeremiah <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Zephaniah)</p>
<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Written to the returned remnant in Jerusalem, he encouraged to finish the temple for the coming Messiah Had a series of eight visions, four messages and two burdens Described a future that includes God's victory for Judah and Christ's second coming <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Zechariah)</p>	<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Last appeal of the Old Testament for Judah to repent and return to God Proclaims the coming of the Lord Name means "my messenger", he spoke of a "messenger of the covenant" who has yet to come <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Malachi)</p>

<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sin entered the world through him when he disobeyed • Named the animals • First man <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Adam)</p>	<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He and his family were the only righteous people in a world that had become so violent and evil • Found favor with God, and God gave him specific building instructions • Survived the flood <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Noah)</p>
<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Born approximately 2100 BC and lived a life of luxury in Ur before God called him • God gave him three promises • God chose him to be the father of a great nation • One of three great patriarchs <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Abraham)</p>	<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Had 12 sons who became the 12 tribes of Israel • Called the Father of Israel • Had one son who was sold into slavery in Egypt by his brothers • Marries Rachel <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Jacob)</p>
<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Falsely accused and imprisoned in Egypt • Became the second in command of the nation of Egypt • Reunited with his family and saved them from famine by coming to live with him <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Joseph)</p>	<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Led the people to Mt. Sinai • Wrote the Pentateuch • God told him, “You shall have no other gods before me” • God gave him instructions on how to build a tabernacle for God to dwell among the center of the people <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Moses)</p>
<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Took Moses’ place of leadership • Conquered and settled the Promised Land • God parted the Jordan River and he led the children of Israel into the Promised Land • Defeated Jericho in a most unusual manner <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Joshua)</p>	<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Female judge • Led Israel to victory against Jabor, king of Canaan • Under her rule, Israel enjoyed peace for 40 years <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Deborah)</p>

<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Judge who led Israel to victory against the Midianites • Judge who was afraid and hid in the wine press • Under his rule, Israel enjoyed peace for 40 years <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Gideon)</p>	<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Judge who destroyed the Philistine rulers • Like Isaac, his birth was announced by the angel of the Lord • Was weak in self-control though had unusual strength <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Samson)</p>
<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Takes place during the time of Judges, and started with travels from Moab but ends in the birthplace of redemption, Bethlehem • Marries her kinsman redeemer • Son becomes the grandfather of King David <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Ruth)</p>	<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Last judge • He led the people in the position of judge, priest and prophet • The people demanded a king but he warned them that this is not God's will • Announces David would be the next King after Saul <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Samuel)</p>
<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Confronted by Nathan about his sin • United all of the tribes under his monarchy • Man after God's own heart • Was promised a descendant would sit on the throne of Israel forever <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (David)</p>	<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wrote a love poem about marriage • Built the temple in Jerusalem • God gave him great wisdom <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Solomon)</p>
<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prophet who proved God's power on Mt. Carmel • Taken to heaven in a whirlwind • Lived in the Northern Kingdom during the reign of King Ahab <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Elijah)</p>	<p>Who Am I?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sent by God to renew the spiritual lives of the people who had returned to Jerusalem (almost 50,000) to rebuild the temple after opposition had stopped the work • During his time, the temple is rebuilt • Lived during the 1st and 2nd return <p>© Big Dream Ministries, Inc (Ezra)</p>
