

1. The testimony of John the Baptist proclaims this about Jesus, and that He comes to take away the sin of the world. – Lamb of God

2. Jesus first reveals this claim to the Samaritan woman at the well. - Messiah

3. Existed before time, space, and matter. - Preexistent Creator

4. Matthew and Luke record the genealogy of Jesus as the son of David and the son of Abraham, and the lineage from Joseph back to Adam. – **God Sent**

5. Jesus cast out demons, healed the sick with a spoken word, and wherever He went, diseases were cured. – **Healer**

6. The best example of this attribute is Jesus' teaching of the Sermon on the Mount, the Beatitudes, and the Lord's Prayer – all point to our heart and not our deeds. – **Teacher of Righteousness**

7. "Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest." Matthew 11:28 – **Burden** Bearer

8. The daughter of a synagogue official died and Jesus brought her back to life by saying, "Little girl, I say to you, get up." – Life Giver

9. Jesus spoke to the crowds in parables, with the Kingdom of Heaven as the central theme. - Storyteller

10. The Pharisees considered it blasphemy when Jesus rightly claimed, "I and the Father are one." John 10:30 – **Equal to God**

11. The image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. - Preexistent Creator

12. The great physician. – Healer

13. Jesus replaces the heavy burdens of self-righteousness and self-sufficiency with His grace and rest. – **Burden Bearer**

14. "Anointed One" – Messiah

15. Jesus described the Kingdom of Heaven like a treasure hidden in the field, a merchant seeking fine pearls, and a dragnet cast into the sea. – **Storyteller**

16. "He who has found his life will lose it, and he who has lost his life for My sake will find it." Matthew 10:39 – Life Giver

17. An angel of the Lord announced to Zacharias the future birth of the forerunner of Christ, John the Baptist. The angel Gabriel announced to Mary the future birth of the Messiah. An angel of the Lord announced the birth of the Savior to the shepherds. – **God Sent**

18. Jesus came as the ultimate sacrifice for our sins. – Lamb of God

19. There are four witnesses to this claim: John the Baptist, Jesus' works, the voice of the Father at Jesus' baptism, and scripture. – **Equal to God**

20. Jesus went up on the mountain, sat down, and began teaching His disciples. – **Teacher of Righteousness**

21. Jesus said, "He who comes to Me will not hunger, and he who believes in Me will never thirst." We must have an appetite for God, seeking that which actually satisfies. This is the embodiment of God's goodness and love. – **Bread of Life**

22. Jesus asks Peter, "Who do you say that I am?" Peter answered, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." – Son of God
