Questions with answers:

1. Name the town where Mary and Joseph were from. **Nazareth**
2. Name the town where Jesus was born. **Bethlehem, City of David**
3. Who came to visit the Christ child? **Shepherds, wise men**
4. Name three prophets who prophesied of the coming Messiah (there are several). **Micah, Isaiah, Zechariah, Jeremiah, Malachi, Daniel, Hosea, Writers of Psalms**
5. Who saw an angel in the temple and then became mute? And Why? **Zacharias (alternate spelling in Luke ESV "Zechariah"). Struck mute because of unbelief.**
6. Who had a baby in old age? **Elizabeth**
7. By what body of water did John the Baptist preach and baptize? **Jordan River**
8. What was John the Baptist's initial message to the people? **"Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."**
9. Name three ways Jesus was tempted in the wilderness. **Lust of the eyes, lust of the flesh, pride of life OR to provide for Himself, protect Himself, exalt Himself**
10. Name the 12 disciples. **Andrew, Simon Peter, James, John (sons of Zebedee), Philip, Nathaniel (aka Bartholomew), Matthew (aka Levi), Thomas, James (son of Alphaeus), Thaddaeus (aka Jude), Simon the Zealot, and Judas Iscariot**
11. Where did Jesus turn water into wine? What was the sign it was meant for? **A wedding in Cana. The water pots used for purification rituals signified old ways of cleansing, it's work, no joy in it; the new wine signified being washed by the blood of the Lamb, JOY. We were made for the new wine.**
12. What did Jesus do in the temple at his first visit after beginning His ministry? **Cleansed the temple, threw out money changers, overturned tables, zeal for the LORD**
13. To whom did Jesus say "For God so loved the world..."? **Nicodemus**
14. Who was the first person Jesus revealed Himself to as the Messiah? **Samaritan woman at the well**

15. What did the people of Nazareth try to do to Jesus after He read Isaiah to them in their synagogue? **Became angry and tried to kill Him "...no prophet is welcome in his hometown"**
16. What city did Jesus make His home base? Why? **Capernaum. Port city, center of commerce, all cultures congregated there**
17. Whose mother-in-law did Jesus heal from a fever? **Simon Peter**
18. How was the paralytic in Capernaum able to get an audience with Jesus? **His four friends lowered him through the roof of the house where Jesus was teaching.**
19. Give three reasons why the Pharisees were against Jesus. **He healed on the Sabbath, He claimed to be equal to God, He forgave sins, He associated with sinners**
20. Why was Jesus "against" the Pharisees? **They had no mercy, no compassion, they oppressed God's people, they didn't see that they were sick and needed a Savior, they were not for God, they did not believe Moses, they sought glory for themselves not God, they did not love God or God's people**
