Disciples (fishermen, tax collector), Mary, Martha, Lazarus, Mary Magdalene, sinners

4. Who were some of the people who did not believe in Jesus?

Pharisees

5. Name three people who were raised from the dead.

Lazarus, Widow's son, Jarius' daughter, Jesus

6. When did the triumphal entry into Jerusalem take place: beginning, middle or end of His ministry?

End

7. What happened on the Mount of Transfiguration?

Peter, James, and John were shown Jesus in all His glory with Moses and Elijah.

8. Thinking about the circumstances surrounding this event, why did Peter deny Christ?

Fear (he was afraid)

9. What happened right after Jesus breathed His last?

The veil tore in two, from top of bottom, and tombs were opened.

The Upper Room Discourse (praying for you, will bring a Helper) – Matthew 26, Luke, John 13, Mark 14 (Kingdom – Power)

11. What did the Jews do to secure Christ's tomb?

Guarded with Roman soldiers and sealed it.

12. How did Jesus show His omnipotence (all powerful), omnipresence (everywhere), omniscience (knows everything)? Give an example for each.

Omnipotence – raised people from the dead, miracles

Omnipresence – healed from afar

Omniscience – woman at the well, foretold His death

13. What must you do to be saved?

Repent and believe in Jesus as your Lord and Savior, the Son of God who was crucified and resurrected on the third day to pay the price for our sins.

14. What benefits come with salvation?

Eternal heaven, peace, forgiveness, fellowship

15. Why did Christ have to die?
