

### **Quiz Bowl Instructions**

#### **Supplies Needed**

- Whiteboard or poster board •
- Markers •
- Small prize such as candy (optional)
- Quiz bowl guestions bank

#### Setup

- On whiteboard or poster board, make a list of numbers 1 36. 6 rows of 6 numbers work well.
- Create a score tracker based on number of teams up to 4 teams.

#### **Playing Instructions**

- Divide the players into teams.
- Choose a game moderator, if not the instructor.
- Decide which team will go first and which player on each team will go first. •
- When it is a person's turn, they chose any open number from the board. They do not need to choose in any particular order.
- The game moderator will mark an "X" through the chosen number on the board and read the corresponding question from the quiz bowl question bank.
- The player may seek help from their team, but must give the final answer. Allow an appropriate amount of time – 20 to 30 seconds is more than enough.
- If the player gives a correct answer, mark one tally point on their team's score tracker. The turn now goes to the opposing team.
- If the player answers incorrectly, the other team may have a brief time to answer. If the opposing team • answers correctly, they receive the point. Whether the opposing team answers correctly or incorrectly, they then proceed with their turn by choosing the next number.
- Each team must rotate through the players with each new turn.
- The game ends when there are no more questions or the time is up. The team with the most points • wins. Optionally - distribute prizes to the winning team.
