Name the attribute of Christ from Part Two that matches each statement below.

1. Jesus is gentle, cares for us, knows us, hears us and we recognize His voice, and He gave up His life to save us. What attribute of Jesus is shown here?

Hint: Psalm 23

2. This attribute of Christ is also known as the first thing God created, it exposes evil in the darkness, it brings warmth and comfort, and Jesus calls us into it as a call to holiness.

3. The disciples learned to ask for what they needed through Jesus' example of the Lord's Prayer. What attribute does this show of Jesus?

4. There is one way to God. You cannot go around it. It is open to everyone, but there is a decision and a deadline.

5. Jesus brings Lazarus back to life after he had been dead for four days.

Hint: Jesus said to Lazarus' sister, Martha: *"I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies, and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die. Do you believe this?"*

6. During the last week of Jesus' life, He triumphantly enters the city of Jerusalem. The children begin to sing and shout this about Jesus.

Hint: "Hosanna to the Son of David!"

7. Jesus spoke about the end times at the Olivet Discourse. When Jesus comes again, it will be to do this.

8. At the last supper, Jesus tells the disciples He is going away to prepare a place for them and so that a Helper can come. They ask Jesus how this is possible. Jesus answers with this "I am" statement about Himself. Hint: Jesus says, *"I am the Way, and the Truth, and the Life; no one comes to the Father but through Me."* John 14:6

9. Jesus calls Himself this, and is mentioned over 80 times. It emphasizes Jesus' humanity in His suffering.

10. Jesus demonstrated this attribute on the cross.

Hint: Prophecy of Isaiah 53:3-5

He was despised and rejected by men,  
a man of suffering who knew what sickness was.  
He was like someone people turned away from;  
He was despised, and we didn't value Him.  
Yet He Himself bore our sicknesses,  
and He carried our pains;  
but we in turn regarded Him stricken,  
struck down by God, and afflicted.  
But He was pierced because of our transgressions,  
crushed because of our iniquities;  
punishment for our peace was on Him,  
and we are healed by His wounds.

Hint: Jesus says, *"I am the Way, and the Truth, and the Life; no one comes to the Father but through Me."* John 14:6

9. Jesus calls Himself this, and is mentioned over 80 times. It emphasizes Jesus' humanity in His suffering. – **Son of Man**

10. Jesus demonstrated this attribute on the cross. – **Suffering Servant**

Hint: Prophecy of Isaiah 53:3-5
